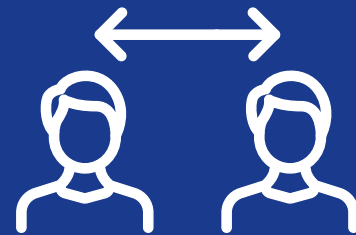

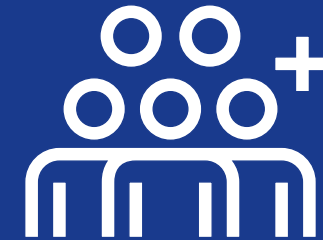
Please work with us to stop the spread of coronavirus in our Province by making safer choices:

Keep at least 1.5 meters apart from others.

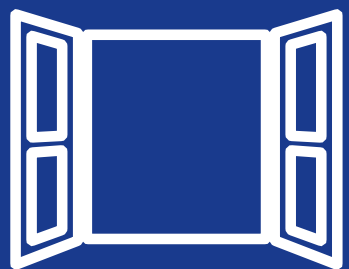


Avoid crowds, close-contact and confined and enclosed spaces.

1 Have ready a **COVID-19 negative test certificate** from an accredited laboratory, obtained less than 72 hours before the date of travel. If this is not possible, you will need to quarantine at a government designated facility, at your own cost, for 10 days.

2 Complete the “**Traveller health questionnaire**” prior to entering the terminal building. Access questionnaires at: **www.airports.co.za**

3 The **COVID Alert SA app** can notify you if you have been exposed to another app user with coronavirus. Download it now to protect yourself and others.



DOES

- keep app user identities private at all times
- protect app user security at all times



DOES NOT

- use GPS
- track your location
- ask you for or ever store your name, surname or other identifying details
- require access to your contacts on your phone
- require access to your health information
